HOOKER ROAD OVER NORTH BRANCH PLATTE RIVER

CONSTRUCTION OF SINGLE SPAN TIMBER BRIDGE

BENZIE COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION

Sealed bids for construction of a single span timber bridge on Hooker Road over the North Branch Platte River are requested and will be received until **1:00 p.m. on September 12, 2018**, at the Benzie County Road Commission Office, 11318 Main Street (US-31), P.O. Box 68, Honor, MI 49640, at which time they will be opened and read aloud. Please include the PO Box in the address as the Post Office will not deliver to the street address.

Work on this project includes traffic control for a road closure, excavation, timber bridge construction, guardrail and HMA paving as detailed on the plans and specifications. All piles and structure materials will be supplied by Krenn Timber Bridge, Inc. and delivered to the project site. Supply of Timber Bridge materials is not a part of this construction bid.

Work shall not start before **October 1, 2018**. Hooker Road shall be open to traffic with the closure removed by **November 14, 2018**. The final project completion date is **November 14, 2018**. Once work is started, it shall be continuous until open-to-traffic.

Plans and Specifications will be on file and available from 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday - Thursday through **August 31, 2018** and starting on **September 4, 2018** 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday at the Benzie County Road Commission Office. Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the provided Bid Form.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after the scheduled time for the receipt of the bids.

All proposals must be in sealed envelopes, plainly marked as to contents and the name of the bidder. Telephone or faxed bids will not be accepted. The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, to waive any irregularities in the bids, and to award the bid in a manner deemed in the best interests of Benzie County.
