For proposed improvements to Miller Road in Benzie County Michigan

PRE-QUALIFICATIONS:

Bidders shall be pre-qualified by the Michigan Department of Transportation or have available, upon request, three references of previous work experience including the company name, address, phone and a contact person.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

The contractor shall at all times exercise extreme care and shall hold the Benzie County Road Commission harmless from any claims or damages. Contractors working within the road right-of-way shall have a valid proof of Auto Liability, Worker's Compensation and Commercial General Liability Insurance. Certificates shall be on file with the Road Commission prior to the start of any work.

SUBCONTRACTING:

The approval of the Road Commission shall be obtained prior to any substantial work being subcontracted. The contractor shall assure that any subcontractor named has sufficient equipment, insurance and personnel to properly complete any item of work within the specified time.

NOTICE TO BIDDER: A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on site on Tuesday May 29, 2018 at 1pm. Sealed proposals will be received by the Benzie County Road Commission at the following address until 1:00 p.m., on Thursday, June 7, 2018 at which time, the bids will be opened and read publicly. All proposals must be in sealed envelopes, plainly marked as to the contents and the name of the bidder. Telephone or faxed bids will not be accepted.

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Supplemental Specifications

PROJECT LOCATION:

The project is on Miller Road approximately 0.5 mile north of Aylsworth Road to Lost Lake Road. The project area was logged during the winter of 2017/2018 and is approximately 1500' x 66'.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Removal and disposal of all stumps, limbs, branches, exposed roots and associated debris from the cleared right-of-way area, followed by rough grading of the area (to allow for future mowing of the area by others to prevent tree regrowth).

PROJECT SCHEDULE:

All work shall be done in accordance with BCRC Standards, and Special Provisions, and as directed by the BCRC. All project work shall be completed on or before July 1, 2018.

MAINTAINING TRAFFIC:

Miller Road in the project area will be closed to through traffic, local residents only. Road closure signage shall be set up and maintained by the BCRC. Contractor will be expected to allow residents ingress and egress from homes within a reasonable amount of time. Contractor will be responsible to leave road in passable condition after hours for local residents. All work shall be confined to daylight hours. No work shall be performed on holidays as determined by the BCRC and contractor must give at least 24-hour notice before work begins on any project.

UTILITY COORDINATION:

For protection of underground utilities and in conformance with Public Act 53, the contractor shall dial, 1-800-482-7171 a minimum of three full working days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays prior to beginning each excavation in areas where public utilities have not been previously located. Members will thus be routinely notified. This does not relieve the contractor of the responsibility of notifying utility owners who may not be part of the "Miss Dig" alert system.

CONTRACTOR COORDINATION:

The contractor is responsible to coordinate work activities and construction signage with contractor(s) performing adjacent project work. No claims for extra compensation or adjustments will be allowed on account of delay or failure of others to complete work as scheduled.

MAILBOXES:

Any mailboxes, paper tubes, etc. requiring relocation due to contractor operations shall be salvaged and reset by the contractor. The cost for this work shall be borne on the contractor.
