**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

**US-31 Between Leelanau Street & Deadstream Road**  
**Mill & Repave Project**

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS:** Sealed proposals will be received by the Benzie County Road Commission (BCRC) at 11318 Main Street, PO Box 68, Honor, MI 49640 until **9:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 12, 2020**. All bids will be publicly opened and read at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Road Commissioners to be held at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, March 12, 2020. Bids shall be in accordance with the specifications obtainable from the road commission office. Bids shall be submitted on the forms provided, in sealed envelopes plainly marked as to the contents, and shall include the name of the bidder. Emailed, faxed, telephoned or texted bids will not be accepted. **Bids sent through the US Mail MUST include the PO Box number. The USPS does not assure delivery of our current day's mail until 11:00 a.m. The US Postal Service does not forward improperly addressed mail; this could result in bids not arriving on time.** Bids will be tabulated and a recommendation will be made to the Board of County Road Commissioners at their next regular meeting, tentatively scheduled for March 26, 2020.

PRE-QUALIFICATIONS - Bidders shall be pre-qualified by the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) or have available, upon request, three references of previous work experience including the company name, address, phone, and contact person. Sub-contracting any portion of the work must be pre-approved by BCRC.

**MATERIALS:**

1. HMA MIXTURE REQUIREMENTS –The bituminous mixture shall be 4E1 with PG 58-28 liquid asphalt. Air voids shall not exceed 3%. The recycled asphalt content (RAP) shall not exceed 20%. The yield shall be as shown on the individual project sketches.
2. The Nuclear Gauge Method for testing compaction is hereby waived for this project. The Number of Rollers Method chart below shall apply: (Nuclear Gauge may be used to determine rolling pattern)

Number of Rollers Required Based on Placement Rate:

Average Laydown Rate, Square Yards Per Hour	Number of Rollers Required	
	Compaction Rollers	Finish Rollers
Less than 800	1	*1
800 - 1800	1	1

\* The compaction roller may be used as the finish roller also.

3. HMA VALLEY GUTTER – This work shall consist of placing and compacting the specified bituminous mixture at locations as shown on the plans or as directed by the BCRC, to form an 18”-24” wide valley gutter (bituminous curb). The valley gutter shall be placed monolithically with the top course of bituminous paving. Valley gutter shall be paid for as “HMA VALLEY GUTTER, LFT”, and shall be for labor and equipment only. The materials shall be paid for as “BITUMINOUS MIXTURE \_\_\_\_, TON.”
4. The materials list and plans are attached to this bid form.

SCOPE OF WORK: The work to be completed includes milling five separate 4 inch deep by 7 foot wide trenches along US 31, located between Leelanau Street and Deadstream Road, totaling 340 feet in length. Three 4 inch deep, by 5 feet wide, by 5’-15’ feet long sections. And one 4 inch deep, by 5 feet wide, by 33’ feet long sections. Then repave with two lifts of HMA 4E1 totaling 440#/yard. Spoils hauled off by others.

The Contractor shall carefully protect the property of MDOT, adjacent structures, and utilities both above and below ground. All damages to the property, existing structures, will be remedied by the Contractor by repairing or replacing the same as incidental to the work, and no extra compensation will be allowed.

All materials shall be applied in accordance with the individual manufacturer’s recommendations

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS: Throughout the time work is being performed under this Agreement, Contractor shall obtain and maintain public liability insurance in the sum of not less than ONE MILLION and 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00) for damages relating to any one person or for damages relating to any one occurrence. This insurance policy shall name the Road Commission as an additional named insured and shall contain a provision that the policy cannot be terminated, canceled, or substantially altered without thirty (30) days written notice to the Road Commission. Contractor shall provide notice of compliance with this insurance provision before beginning the work to be performed under this Agreement.

INDEMNIFICATION: Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Road Commission, its officers, board members, assigns, agents, servants, employees, and insurance companies from any and all damages, legal fees or expenses, losses, claims and actions which may arise out of performing the services contemplated by this Agreement.

BID PROCEDURES: Bids shall be placed in a sealed envelope, clearly marked on the outside “US-31 Leelanau/ Deadstream Mill & Repave.” Bids must be mailed to or dropped off at the Benzie County Road Commission office. No faxed or electronically submitted bids will be accepted. **Bids sent through the US Mail MUST be sent to: PO Box 68.**

DELAYED ACCEPTANCE, FINAL INSPECTION, AND PAYMENT TO CONTRACTOR: The BCRC Manager and/or Construction Supervisor (or designated representatives) will inspect the project with the Contractor one (1) week prior to the final project completion date. If deficiencies are found, corrective work is required. Complete all corrective work by the final project completion date, or by an agreed upon date. All costs associated with completing this corrective work, to the satisfaction of the BCRC, will be borne by the Contractor.

MISCELLANEOUS: The property may be inspected during daylight hours.

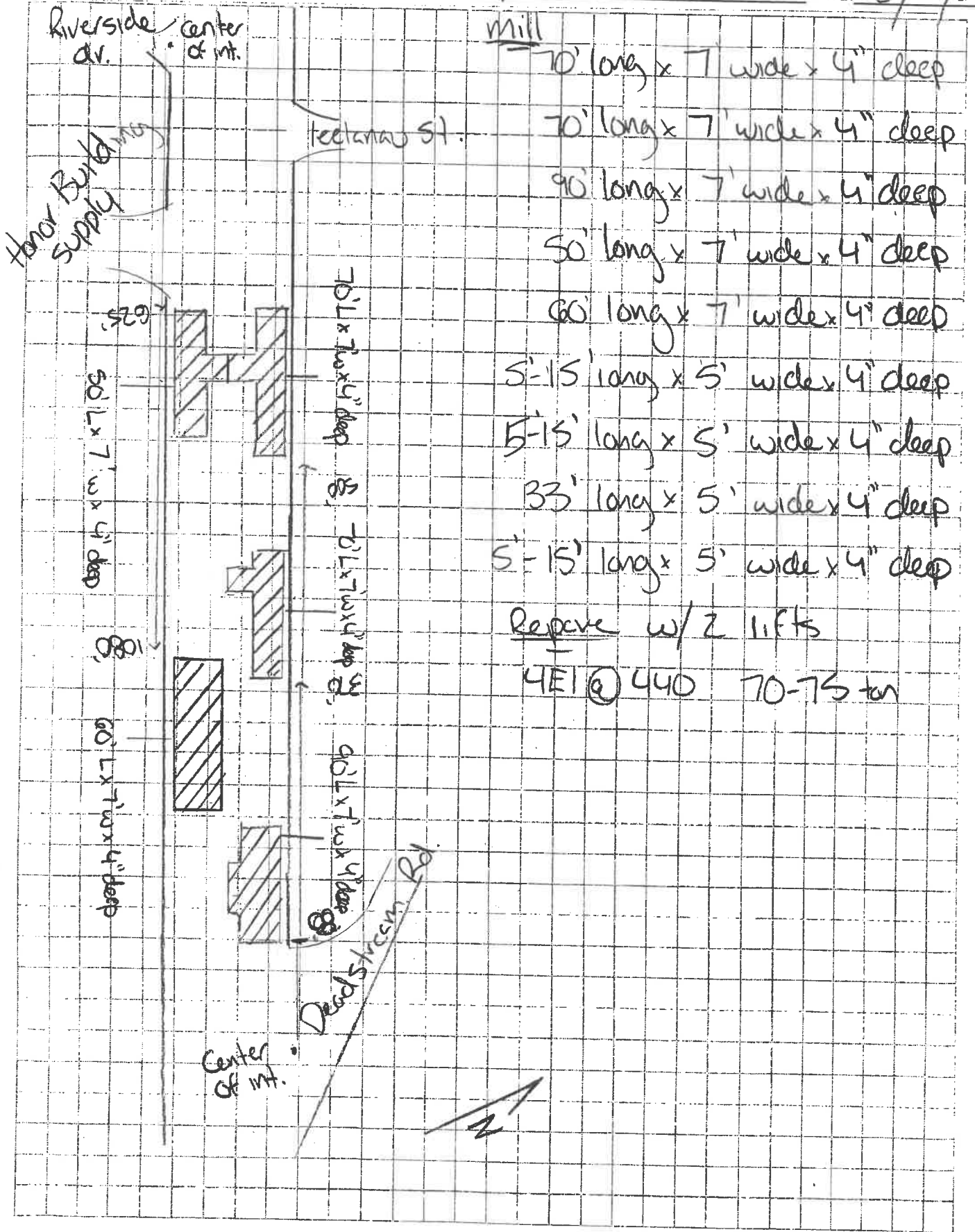
